Emily Jaminet co-authored the award-winning book, *Divine Mercy for Moms* as well as *The Friendship Project*, *PrayFully*, and *Our Friend Faustina*. Her most recent book is *The Secrets of the Sacred Heart*. Emily serves on the Board of Directors for the Columbus Catholic Women's Conference and the John Paul II Preschool, and writes on a regular basis for

Emily earned a bachelor's degree in mental health and human services from the Franciscan University of Steubenville, and was honored by Franciscan with the Bishop John King Mussio Award for Service to the Church in 2018.

Emily offers a daily segment called "A Mother's Moment" on St. Gabriel Catholic Radio and Mater Dei Radio in Oregon. She has spoken to several women's groups and national conferences, speaking on topics ranging from Technology and our Children, to the Early Church Women, St. Faustina and the Divine Mercy Devotion, the importance of Spiritual Friendships, and the Sacred Heart of Jesus Devotion. She has appeared on EWTN twice and is a welcomed guest on Catholic radio programs including Teresa Tomeo, The Jennifer Fulwiler Show, Seize the Day with Gus Lloyd on The Catholic Channel, and is a regular contributor to Relevant Radio: Morning Air, and EWTN's Son Rise Morning Show.

### Liz Kelly



Liz Kelly is a retreat leader and the award-winning author of nine books, including *Reasons I Love Being Catholic*, which won the Catholic Press Association First Place award for Best Popular Presentation of the Faith in 2007. Her book, *Jesus Approaches: What Contemporary Women Can Learn about Healing, Freedom & Joy from the Women of the New Testament*, has won a number of awards, including Best Book in the Religion/Christianity category for 2017-2019.

More than a thousand women have taken Liz's 8-week study based on *Jesus Approaches*. Her most recent book, *Love Like A Saint, Cultivating Virtue with Holy Women* (March 2021) has been called "penetrating and graceful," "a source of encouragement and hope," and "a beautiful deep dive into the lives of inspirational, holy women." Her written works frequently appear in the *Magnificat's* Lenten and Advent Companions and in other Catholic venues, such as the *Catholic Spirit*, *Blessed is She*, and *Jesuitprayer.org*. Her popular monthly column, "Your Heart, His Home," is published throughout the US and has been made into a book.

Liz received her certification as a spiritual director from the Cenacle of our Lady of Divine Providence School of Spirituality in association with the Franciscan University of Steubenville in 2015. She focuses on the Ignatian exercises and leads retreats with a particular focus on helping women to flourish in their faith. Liz has appeared on Relevant Radio, Catholic Answers, Radio Maria, Public Radio, Boston Catholic Television, EWTN and Salt and Light Television. She is presently the managing editor of *Logos: A Journal of Catholic Thought and Culture* at the University of St. Thomas (MN) and teaches in the Catholic Studies program. She is co-host, along with David Deavel, of the Logos podcast, "Deep Down Things."
